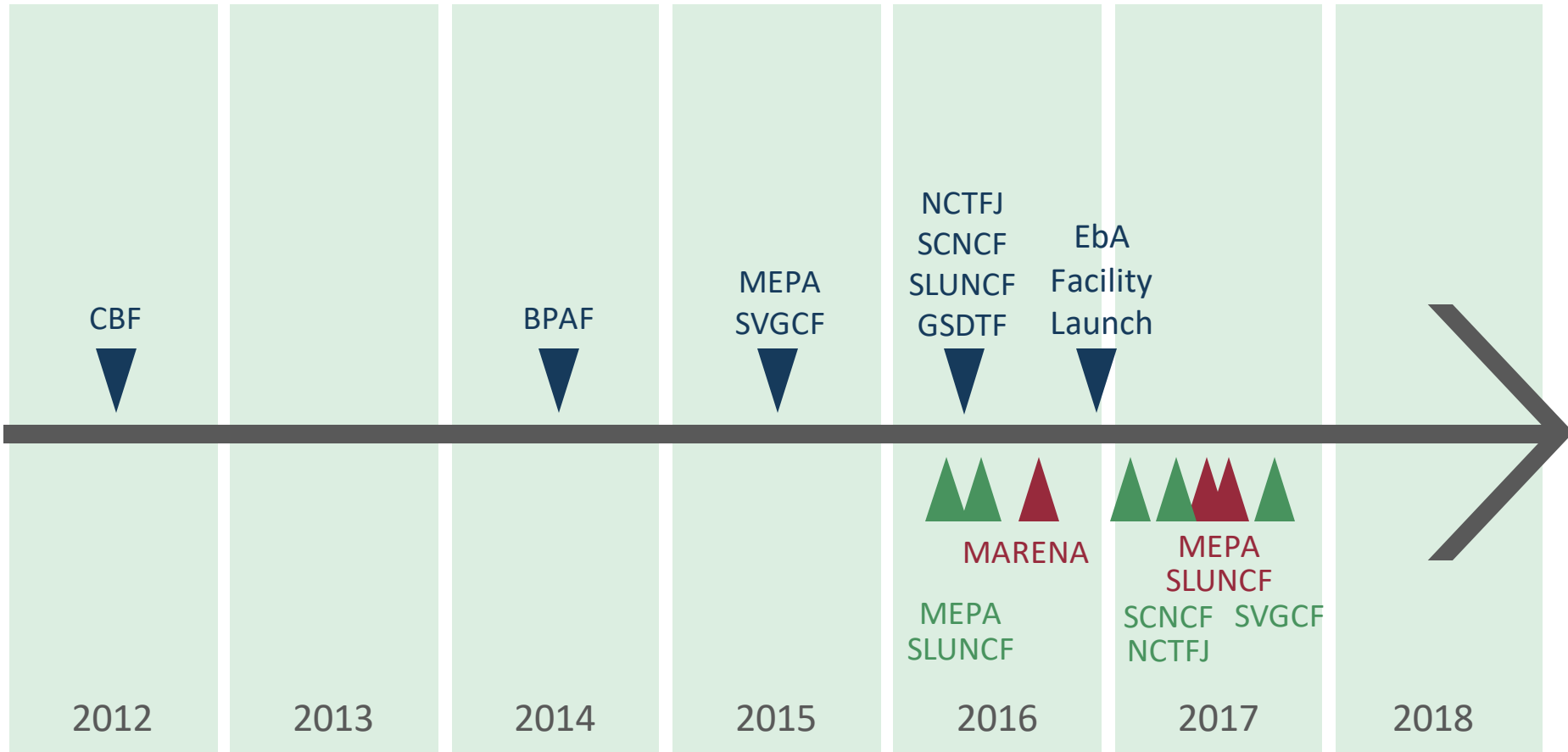

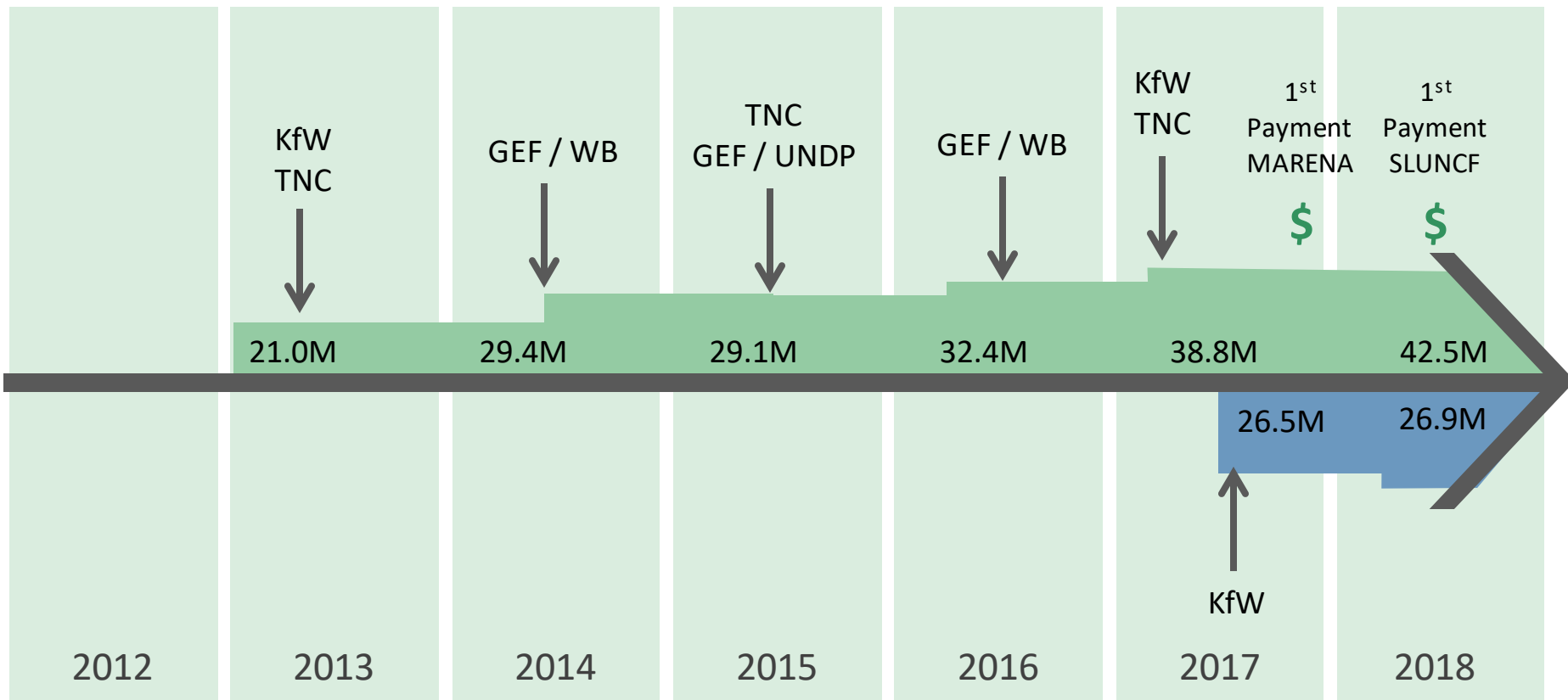

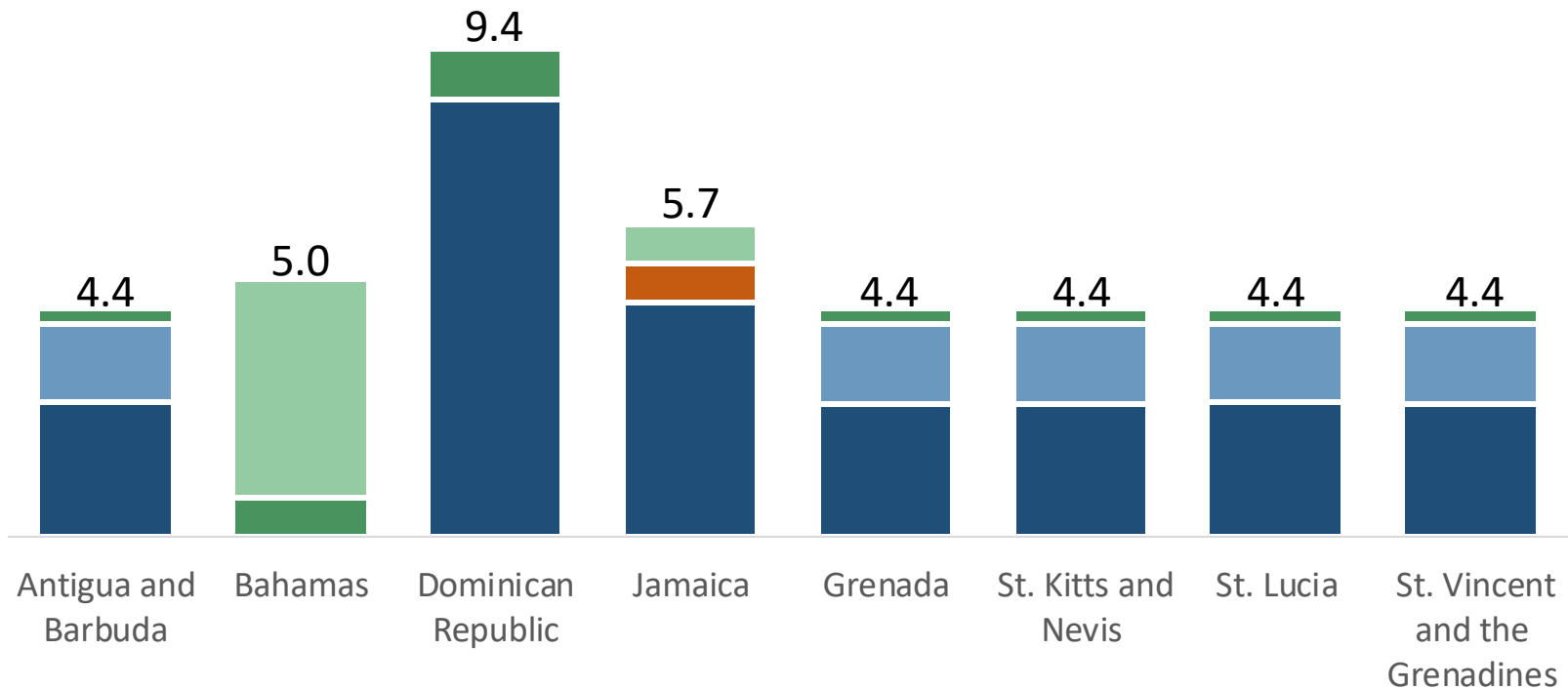

Ecosystem-based Adaptation Facility



Ecosystem-based Adaptation is the most recent component of the CBF's Financial Architecture.

KfW awarded a grant to establish the 5-year Euros \$25 M EbA Facility (December 2016).

The grant was established as a sinking fund of the CBF

The EbA Facility will award grants to support a wide range of EbA actions across the Caribbean during 2018.

- Improved management of Protected Areas
- Reduction of land-based stressors
- Measures to reduce physical damage to ecosystems
- Measures to reduce pressure on ecosystems
- Rehabilitation of natural ecosystems
- Installation of artificial reefs
- Measures of grey infrastructure relevant to EbA approach
